WHEREAS, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at **NORTH PLATTE, NEBRASKA,**
has been deposited in the General Land Office, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress of May 20, 1862,
"To Secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of
THEODORE L. BURES
has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the **SECTION FIVE IN TOWNSHIP SEVEN-**
TEEN NORTH OF RANGE FORTY WEST OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, NEBRASKA,
CONTAINING SIX HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE AND SEVENTY-TWO-HUNDREDTHS ACRES,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor-General:

NOW KNOW YE, That there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said claimant the tract of Land above described;
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of
the said claimant forever; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by
the authority of the United States.
